DISCIPLINARY MEASURES AND SANCTIONS

- My club may make my parent or guardian aware of any infringements of the code of conduct.
- Be required to apologize to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.
